

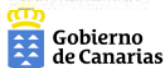

Objetives

Contribute to mitigating climate change from the agricultural sector (as an economic sector that contributes to the fixation of greenhouse gases, or GHGs) and help this sector to adapt to the effects derived from climate change, offering economically viable, complete, exact, transparent measurement parameters and methodology and economic monitoring that is widely accepted by the EU-27 farming sector and applicable to most of the different agricultural production sectors.

SPECIFIC PROJECT OBJECTIVES

-  The development of pilot demonstration strategies for energy efficiency and reduction of GHGs emission in different farming systems of the four most important farm economies of the European Union: France, Spain, Italy and Germany. Such pilot programs should be easily transferable to the rest of European Union agriculture.
-  Combine the different studies existing in the European Union and systems of evaluation and energy auditing that now are applied minimally, sporadically, and with very different criteria in some countries of the EU.
-  Preparation of a common and easily applicable and comprehensible tool for the evaluation of energy balances and GHG emissions that could be adopted in the future throughout the EU and would give us a framework for comparing European farming systems.
